THE QUARANTINE ACT (CAP Q2 LFN 2004)

EKITI STATE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (PREVENTION OF INFECTION) REGULATIONS NO 3, 2020

WHEREAS In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Ekiti State, I issued the Ekiti State Coronavirus Disease (Prevention of Infection) Regulations, 2020 having declared COVID 19 a dangerous infectious disease;

WHEREAS As part of measures to control and prevent the spread of the disease, I ordered the restriction of movement across the 16 Local Government Areas of Ekiti State for an initial period of 14 days with effect from 30th March, 2020, to enable the Government identify, trace and isolate individuals that have come in contact with confirmed cases, in order to contain the disease;

WHEREAS On the advise of the Ekiti State COVID-19 Taskforce, I ordered the extension of the restriction of movement and curfew for a further period of 14 days with effect from 13th April 2020.

WHEREAS The currently known and available scientific evidence and best practices support the extension of the restriction of movement and curfew in Ekiti State to protect and save lives;

WHEREAS The Ekiti State COVID-19 Taskforce will continue to advise on related public health and emergency management decisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DR. JOHN KAYODE FAYEMI, GOVERNOR, EKITI STATE, FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA, 1999 (AS AMENDED) AND LAWS OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO SECTION 8 OF THE QUARANTINE ACT, CAP Q2 LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA 2004, AND IN AN EFFORT TO CONTROL AND PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID 19 WITHIN EKITI STATE DO HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS;

1. Extension of Restriction/Cessation of Movement in Ekiti State

(a) The Restriction/Cessation of Movement in Ekiti State is extended for a further period of six (6) days until 23.59 Sunday 3rd May, 2020.

(b) The period under curfew shall be from 8pm to 6am daily, during which there shall be no vehicular or human movement

2. Regulations further to Ekiti State Coronavirus Disease (Prevention of Infection) Regulations, 2020

These Regulations are made further to the Ekiti State Coronavirus Disease (Prevention of Infection) Regulations, 2020 and accordingly, all the responsibilities of government

officials, citizens and residents contained in the said Regulations remain extant except:


3. Exemptions in the Ekiti State Coronavirus Disease (Prevention of infection) Regulations, 2020 Extant
