# INTERIM REPORT OF EKITI STATE COVID-19 RESPONSE RESOURCE MOBILIZATION COMMITTEE (RRMC) ON THE 2ND JUNE, 2020

## INTRODUCTION

On the 3rd of April, 2020, the Executive Governor of Ekiti State, Dr John Kayode Fayemi constituted a 62-member Committee, named Ekiti State COVID-19 Response Resource Mobilization Committee, in response to the outbreak of Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) and discovery of an index case in the State.

This was obviously in realisation that more than government resources would be required to respond robustly to the challenges that the Coronavirus Pandemic would pose to the Government and people of the State. Government has initially set up a Task Force, whose membership was entirely Government officials, to coordinate the State's response and fight against the pandemic.

Upon inauguration of the committee members (See Annexe 1) the Governor charged the Committee with the responsibility of reaching out to Ekiti sons and daughters at home in Nigeria and in the diaspora, to seek the support in cash and in kind, and their valuable networks to attract an effective support base to respond to the threats posed by the pandemic to the health of Ekiti citizens and residents.

The Terms of Reference (ToR) of the Committee are as follows:

- Mobilizing resources
- Identify and solicit funding channels/sources
- Direct funding campaigns and implement projects related to COVID 19 Response and other issues
- Carry out any other activities as may be directed by the Governor.

Membership was drawn from various background of human endeavours and consist of distinguished Ekiti sons and daughters with extensive experiences and expertise.

Prince Julius Adelusì-Adeluyi was appointed as the Chairman of the Committee and the Special Adviser to the Governor on Development Partnership, Mrs Margaret Fagboyo, was nominated as the Secretary.

The Committee was inaugurated on 9th April, 2020 by the Governor during a virtual meeting attended by the Grand Patron, Aare Afe Babalola, the Patrons who are past Governors of the State, namely Otunba Niyi Adebayo, Dr Ayodele Fayose and Engineer Segun Oni, as well as the Committee Chairman and other members of the Committee.

The Governor thanked all Committee members for responding enthusiastically to the call to bring their knowledge, wealth of experience, expertise and notable contacts to support Ekiti State in the fight against COVID-19. He tasked the Committee to be far reaching in their approach and assured them that government is ready to accept fresh ideas on fighting coronavirus and would provide every support that may be required.

The Chairman, Prince Julius Adelusì-Adeluyi while accepting the responsibility on behalf of the Committee, assured the Governor that the Committee members would put their best into not just overcoming the challenges of COVID-19, but also doing Ekiti people very proud through the quality of their contributions. He expressed our commitment and readiness to meet the

expectations and fulfil the mandate. He also indicated that relevant Government functionaries would be invited to join the committee to facilitate better communication and alignment to State hierarchy and structures.

As part of the decisions during the inaugural meeting and based on the suggestion of the Grand Patron, Aare Afe Babalola, the Governor agreed that the committee tenure will extend beyond Covid-19 to address other matters arising.

## **CENTRAL WORKING COMMITTEE AND SUB-COMMITTEES**

The Chairman indicated that the Committee assignment would be better pursued through cells or subcommittees. Consequently, members were grouped into the following subcommittees (See Annexe 2)

Central Working Committee - A Central Working Committee was set up under the leadership of the Chairman and composed of other eight members. The CWC coordinates the overall activities of the Committee and receive periodic reports and recommendations from the Sub-committees. Sub-Committees - Six (6) other Sub- Committees were set up to work on different areas and target activities. Each of the sub-committees has a Chairman and a co-chairman to direct their affairs.

### **Summary of Sub-Committees and their Terms of Reference:**

1. **Central Working Committee** - Prince Julius Adelus- Adeluyi as Chair – To coordinate, monitor, evaluate and supervise funds management including deployment and audit trail for transparency and accountability and to formulate strategy and envision follow up activities.
2. **Medical Logistics and Project Nomination Committee** - Dr Tunji Olowolafe as Chair and Dr Adedamola Dada as Co-Chair.
  - Ascertain Inventory of medical equipment, consumable equipment, face mask, respiratory (Particulate Respirator N95), sanitizers, gloves, PPE etc.
  - Quality Control and to ensure that materials are fit for purpose.
  - Select and nominate projects including isolation centres, support facilities and equipment.
  - Supervising personnel for testing, isolation care and contact tracing.
3. **Fund Raising Committee** - Gbenga Oyebode as Chair and Chief Wole Olanipekun as Co-Chair – Contact corporate bodies, High Net worth Individuals and others for funds.
4. **Federal Government Institutions** - Femi Falana as Chair and Sir Remi Omotoso as Co-Chair – Relating with Federal Governments parastatals, National Assembly especially Ekiti Representatives in Presidency and in particular Federal COVID-19 Committee.
5. **Development Finance Committee** - Folusho Olaniyan as Chair and Chief Bayo Awosemusi as Co- Chair – Contact International Institutions as well as High net Individuals of Ekiti citizens in diaspora.
6. **Fund Management and Evaluation Committee** – Remi Omotoso as Chair – To monitor and supervise fund management for transparency, accountability, fund deployment and audit trail record.

## MEETINGS

The Committee holds a weekly meeting - the Central Working Committee meets every Monday and the General Committee meets every Tuesday with the Governor attending the plenary session every first Tuesday of the month for the smooth running of the committee.

## PROGRESS REPORTS & ACHIEVEMENTS

1. **Central Working Committee** – The Committee has held five virtual meetings to discuss progress with various Sub-committee Chairs on proposed interventions plans and projects. All decisions of the Committee are deliberated and approved at this level, before presentation to the general meeting usually held every Tuesday.
2. **Medical Logistics and Project Nomination Subcommittee** – The Subcommittee has held four meetings to deliberate and agree on Projects and Two of the proposed projects have been approved by the CWC for implementation.

### 2.1 Testing

The subcommittee has been able to attract Molecular Diagnostic Laboratory to Ekiti State, to be installed at Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital. With the installation, Ekiti State will be able to carry out its own Community Testing and can thus be more scientific in its deployment of resources in combating the pandemic.

Add to this is the benefit of the Laboratory to EKSUTH for testing for other infectious diseases.

- **Funding:** Payment of the sum of 50million has been made to 54gene with an outstanding balance of 60million to be paid.
- **Progress:** The Molecular Diagnostic Laboratory has now been delivered at EKSUTH. Installation process ongoing.
- **Details:** From May, testing for about 10,000 people would commence and the subcommittee had secured a commitment for funding to take the testing to 20,000. Community Studies would be led by EKSUTH.

### 2.2 Training

The Subcommittee has concluded plans for the training of selected staff (across the broad spectrum) of Ekiti State Ministry of Health to sharpen their performance at this time, and going forward.

- **Funding:** Governor has approved the payment and training has since commenced.
- **Details:** Training of health workers who all have roles to play in the Ekiti State COVID response, including Doctors, Nurses, Pharmacists, Lab Scientist, Ambulance Drivers etc.

### 2.3 Hospital Upgrade Projects

2.3.1 The subcommittee helped in pushing the renovation of Adejuyigbe Specialist Hospital ready to serve as a major isolation center.

2.3.2 The subcommittee is also arranging for the upgrading of Okeyinmi Comprehensive Health. Centre, Ado Ekiti.

- **Justification:**
  - High usage of facility with over 100 deliveries per month.
  - Good location around 2 popular markets.
  - Usage of facility for training by EKSUTH and ABUAD.
- **Nature of Project:** Expansion of existing facility to increase delivery rooms, prenatal services, postnatal services.
- **Cost:** - Presently undergoing detailed evaluation and costing by the committee. Cost to be presented to the CWC for approval once its streamlined.

## 2.4 Health Insurance

Verod Foundation is donating N2billion Life and Health Insurance cover for 500 frontline workers.

3. Fund Raising Subcommittee – The Subcommittee has held five virtual meetings and met with individuals and corporate organisations to raise funds for the State. The detail of Funds raised from March 27th – 30th May is as follows:
  - The total of All donations in cash is **N749, 075, 116.11**
    - o Individuals and Corporate donations - **N666,588, 112.70**
    - o Government Employees donations – **N82, 487,053.41.**
    - o The committee reported that some pledges have not been redeemed but they will continue to provide regular update.
  - Corporate Organizations – Over 80 letters have been sent out to Corporate Organisations. High Net worth Individuals in the community of Ekiti State have been identified and follow up made to them for contribution to COVID19 project.
4. Federal Government Institutions – The Subcommittee has met five times since inception.
  - The updated list of applicants for the CBN /NIRSAL soft loan has been compiled and will be submitted to the CBN soon.
  - The list of applicants for the CBN N50 billion loan for SMEs has been submitted to the CBN.
  - We have confirmed that the 1311 bags of rice received from the Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs and the 800 bags of rice and 450 Bags of 5kg Garri donated by Aare Afe Babalola SAN have been distributed to the people of Ekiti State.
  - The list of 100 federal government agencies and development institutions have been compiled and made available to the subcommittee with a view to raising fund from them. The list ought to be updated for the purpose of ensuring that the quota of Ekiti State is filled up in all federal institutions.
  - The federal government has announced plans to take over the COVID 19 private sector fund and use same to fund its supplementary budget. It is hoped that state governments will demand their share from the fund.
  - With respect to the CBN 100 billion credit facility for health, not less than 13 medical centres have applied through the intervention and encouragement of the Medical, Logistics and Nomination Committee.
5. Development Finance Subcommittee – The Subcommittee Members met five times to deliberate on issues.
  - We now have a list of about 150 (initially 30) from Ekiti Applicants successfully submitted online to NIRSAL. More are still being mobilized via existing MFBs and direct contacts with some Obas in Ekiti. We envisage we might have up to 250 duly submitted applications in the next few days, of Ekitis seeking to partake in the CBN Covid-19 Relief Loans scheme.
  - The first diaspora zoom meeting was held on Saturday 9th May 2020 with 54 attendees. The diaspora leadership stressed the importance of accountability. That they are willing to support Ekiti State in their efforts as long as there is accountability. It was agreed that we hold meetings regularly to foster the relationship.
  - Given the data restrictions in Europe and North America, the first step is to establish a digital platform to convene our citizens in Diaspora. The link for the database is ready, has been launched, and so many have signed up. Link below - <https://forms.gle/6UAmcd9yrpvxRyHA7>
  - Following our correspondence with the Embassy of Hungary, they have offered to train Medical Personnel of our Health Care Centers via the Hungary Helps Program.
  - In 2017, the Hungarian Government launched a governmental framework program called 'Hungary Helps Program' to ensure Hungary's international humanitarian aid and

development activities. These activities have been conducted in developing countries and different crisis areas and have been implemented directly and in a coordinated manner. The Hungary Helps Program embraces the full range of humanitarian and international development activities of the Hungarian government, which is why several ministries are involved in its implementation.

- Hungary Helps is introducing a new program, volunteers are going to train medical personnel e.g. midwives, nurses and ambulance attendants. Although it is not strictly connected to the COVID-19 pandemic, by training of medical personnel Hungary can assist Ekiti State to improve its primary healthcare system. Volunteer trainers will be sent by second half of the year.
6. Fund Management and Evaluation Subcommittee – The Subcommittee was the last to be set up on the 25th April, to monitor fund management for transparency, accountability and audit trail. They have met three times to deliberate on issues bordering on their mandate.
- The draft of the Project Identification, Approval and Funds Disbursement Guidelines along with the Process Flowchart for COVID-19 RRM. It ensures due process for accountability and transparency. It will be submitted to the Central Working Committee at its next meeting for consideration and approval.
  - The Desk Officers on Stock Management of Food Stores and Non-food warehouse have reported for work, reporting to Committee Secretary, Mrs Fagboyo. Spreadsheets for monitoring stock inflow and outflow have been developed and handed over to the Desk Officers. A weekly report is to be issued on these items by Mrs Fagboyo.
  - A COVID 19 RRM Account has been opened with WEMA Bank and Mr. Gbenga Oyebo, Chairman Funds Raising Subcommittee and Mrs Foluso Olaniyan, Chair, DFI Subcommittee are the two signatories. All COVID 19 accounts in other banks have been transferred to Wema bank.
  - There are five Bank Accounts as follows with following balances as at 15th May 2020:
    - Total cash donations amounted to **N749,075,116.11** all deposited in the five Bank accounts.
    - See Annexe 3 for details
    - The Ekiti State Government had spent **N214,808,414.60** from the UBA account, including the N40m paid to **54gene** for Collaboration on Diagnostic Laboratory and COVID 19 testing.
    - A sum of **Nineteen Million, Two hundred and Eighty thousand Naira Only (N19,280,000)** for the Training Programme of Ekiti Ministry of Health Staff has been paid.
    - A sum of **Seventeen Million, Five Hundred and Sixty-six Thousand, One Hundred and Twenty Naira Only (N17,566,120)** for Research and Screening-Representative Sampling Across Ekiti 16 LGAs-TOR 1 has been paid to EKSUTH)
    - Also, **Seventeen Million, Eight Hundred and Ninety-six Thousand, One Hundred and Twenty Naira Only (N17,896,120)** for Covid-19 NCD Surveillance and Intervention in Ekiti State-TOR 2 has been approved and will be paid on the 1st June, 2020.
    - The State Government has asked that the UBA account be left with it for emergency and day-to-day COVID 19 intervention. The Central Working Committee has agreed to the request.

- Mrs Fagboyo will provide a weekly report of bank balance in the WEMA Bank Account to the Funds Monitoring and Evaluation Sub-committee. On a monthly basis, a bank statement will be submitted to the Monitoring and Evaluation Sub-committee for necessary study and action required if any. Mrs Fagboyo has responsibility for this.
- The Secretary has provided a full list of cash and non-cash donors as at 8th May. She has been advised to get value for the non-cash items to enable the Committee a near accurate monetary value of donations to date. This should be available in the next report.
- At the Central/Coordinating Committee meeting on Monday 11th May, the need to provide non-partisan visibility to the efforts of the COVID 19 RRMC in combatting the pandemic was agreed. The Logistics for realizing this will be worked out by the secretariat in consultation with the sub-committee Chairs.

## CONCLUSION

Within a month of the inauguration of the Committee by your Excellency, I am extremely proud of the achievements made by the Committee and the various Sub-committees. In the last few weeks, the various subcommittees have worked assiduously and the results of their efforts are obvious.

Members hit the ground running from Day One and the expertise and experiences of this assemblage of distinguished Ekiti sons and daughters have enriched the tasks and simplified the assignment with great results. Their commitment and cooperation are worthy of commendation. The latest achievements by the Committee is the procurement of the Molecular Diagnostic Laboratory delivered by **54 Gene** on the **15th May, 2020**. We thank you for the commissioning of the Molecular Laboratory on the **1st June, 2020** with the attendance of our Grand Patron, Aare Afe Babalola and other distinguished members of the Committee.

I would like to conclude by thanking His Excellency, the Governor, our Grand Patron, Patrons, the Chairmen, and members of the various committees and Our *Omiyes* from the Diaspora for their enthusiasm and support for this project.
